



International Congress Programme

The 28th German Prevention Congress, including the Annual International Forum (AIF), will take place on June 12 and 13, 2023. This event will be on-site, taking place at the Congress Center Rosengarten in Mannheim, Germany. The AIF encompasses all programme parts of the 28th German Prevention Congress, which are offered in English language.

The main topic of the German Prevention Congress 2023 is "Crises & Prevention". In short, this year's DPT is dedicated to topics such as the perception, impact, handling and preventive approaches to solving current crises. Several developments are described as crises: among others, the climate crisis, the covid pandemic, the worldwide refugee movements or intensifying social conflicts. The 28th German Prevention Congress will highlight and disseminate already existing research findings, solution approaches, promising strategies and measures. In addition, it is intended to identify the research and practical needs that continue to be necessary for crisis management.

Besides the main topic "Crises & Prevention", all other current topics of violence and crime prevention up to the extended field of addiction prevention, public health and traffic safety will be discussed during the congress.
