





17 planning areas, 42 urban districts




Abb. 1: Übersichtskarte der Augsburger Stadtbezirke und Planungsräume

Non CVE related measures

"Heroes"

- A project for gender equality and against suppression on behalf of honor
- HEROES
 gegen Unterdrückung im Namen der Ehre
- Target audience: young men (age 14-18), migration background
- weekly sessions
- reflection of own positions on topics like honor, manhood, gender equality, religious justified radicalisation
- After one year training: workshops in schools (peer to peer)

Non CVE related measures

"Musa – muslim counseling Augsburg" Support of people in emotional crisis



(known) affection by radicalisation

- 1 mosque observed by department for the protection of the constitution
- the only Arabic speaking mosque in Augsburg
 → problem: arabic speaking refugees
- Some young people, who participated in training camps
- Few people, who travel to Arabic states for eventually joining IS



CVE related measures – specific prevention programs

"Connected in Oberhausen"

Thesis:

- local stakeholders have a lack of information about specific behaviour of the youth milieu
- and therefore are mostly not able to distinguish between typical youth behaviour and radicalisation
- Networking of the stakeholders is lacking
- therefore the case-specific handling isn't sufficient
